Questions you should ask yourself before enrolling your child at any Nursery.

The first one is -Are you ready?

It is a big step allowing your child to spend time in a new environment where you do not have control. Are you ready to step back and allow the teachers to do their job?

Tears- Yours and your child's!

It is a very emotional experience walking away from Mummy or Daddy. Even though your child is going to have fun, their attachment to you makes them want to have you standing around to wait for them to finish.

There may well be tears when you leave your child. These usually stop within minutes and are more about the child taking control than actual abandonment issues. Please be assured that if your child is really distressed we will contact you and ask you to come and collect him or her. Can you cope with it?

Rules- Ours!

Like any family Rainbows has to have rules in order to run smoothly. This may mean that you cannot get your desire for your child to be the sole responsibility for the teaching staff. All children are important to us, but all children here are equal.

They receive equal time, care and affection. It is a learning curve for parents as well as children.

Are you ready to accept it?

Fighting and Biting- It is unfortunately normal behavior for littlies.

Very young children cannot express their needs and desires. Very often in the family situation, these desires are catered to almost before the child knows it has them. Doting parents, grandparents and housemaids ensure that the child gets its own way!

This of course is not going to happen in a Nursery. Although the staff will take the best possible care of your child there is not a one to one ratio of staff and part of their job is to teach the child how to operate in a community.

Here at Rainbows we have as many staff as possible on duty at any one time. However very young children are going to lash out at each other from time to time and scratches and bites do happen;.

The staff are trained in how to deal with this and to minimize the number of times it occurs but as parents it is important that you understand that your child well may bite or scratch (even though they never do it at home) or rarely on occasion be the one bitten or scratched.

Parents of children with anger issues are asked to remove their children from Rainbows, but you have to be ready for the occasional 'scrap' to occur.

A friendly kiss or hug can easily turn into a bite when your child is less than three years old!

Are you ready to accept that?

Your child will get sick. -Do you have someone to care for him or her?

Unless your child is routinely playing with children outside the family circle, your child is going to get sick with colds etc, during the first few months. Because it is a new environment with children coming from around the country, your child has no immunity to any germs they may carry on them.

It is no one's fault. Are you ready for that?
